Medicare B Home Safety Assessment

OVERVIEW

Medicare B Home Safety Assessments are provided in order to identify **medically necessary** safety and accessibility issues resulting in a fall within your home.

GOALS

1. Includes functional testing (i.e., mobility, cognition, balance) to focus on the specific, medically indicated problem areas identified at the time of referral.
2. Within this assessment, it is reasonable to expect the OT to have time to address 2-3 areas of the home, such as the bathroom and/or the bedroom and/or the kitchen.

SPECIFICATIONS

This assessment is for individuals who have an acute / urgent need for OT, for example following hospitalization, joint replacement, change in health status, or incidence of fall(s) at home. Also appropriate for caregivers of individuals with advancing dementia with changing needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Recommendations

This assessment involves the functional assessment of the client and observation of the entire home to determine areas where short-term and long-term solutions may be addressed. The OT will provide a written summary of the recommendations to the client at the end of the assessment.

Follow Up Sessions

If needed, for practice and education on equipment, strategies and home exercises geared toward fall prevention, one-hour follow up sessions may be recommended.
